- Strong winds can make the lakes hard to cross. Plan to travel in the morning.

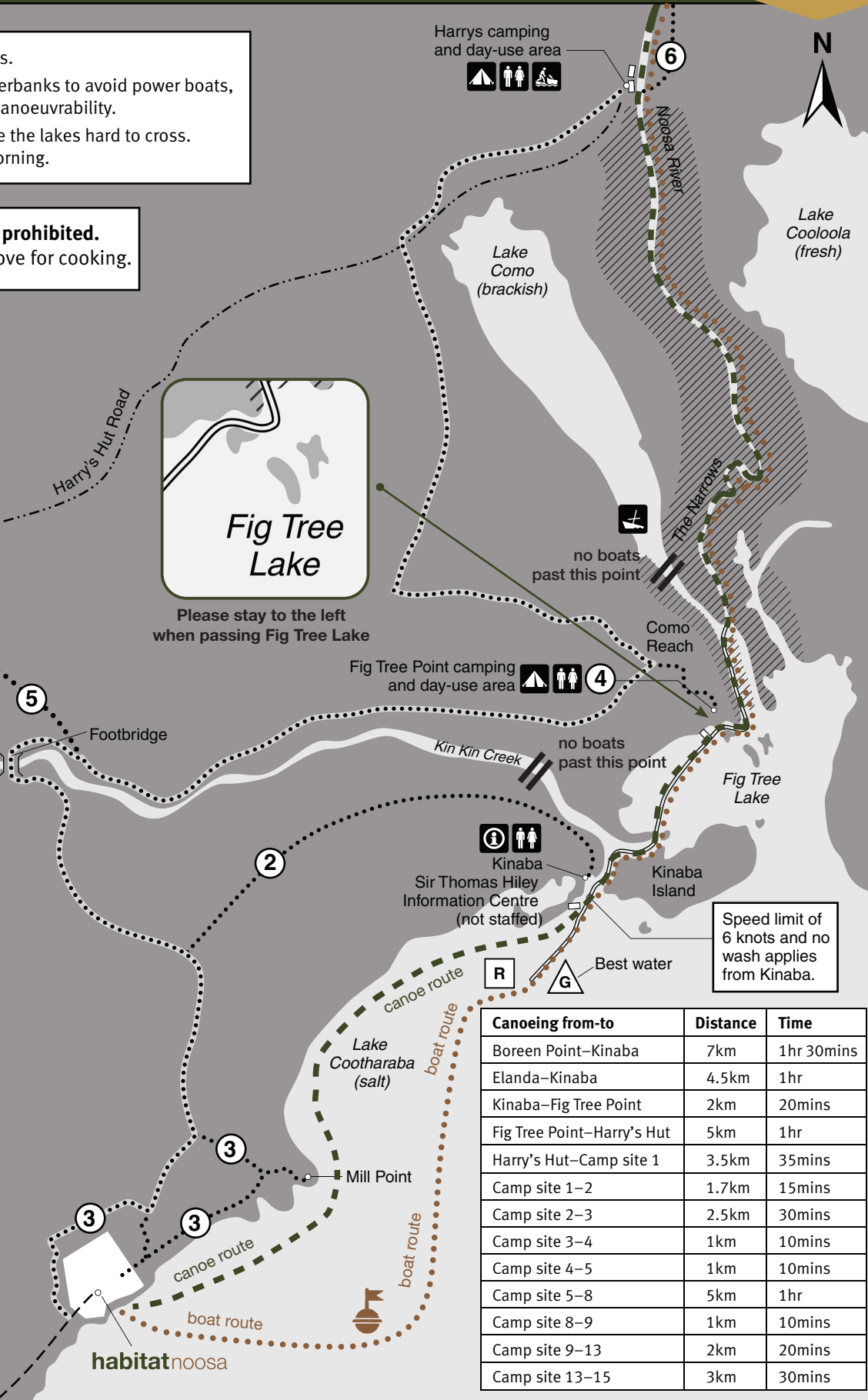
Campfires are prohibited.
