



How to find us

When searching for **habitatnoosa** on your GPS device please search "Elanda Point Road, Elanda Point".

Check In/Check out

Glamping: Check-in time is 3pm

Camping: Check-in time is 12 midday

Check out is 10am for all glamping & camping

***Late departure fee applies after 10am**

Undesignated sites

Please be considerate of the other campers and only take an 8x8m area in any undesignated site.

Vegetation

Guests must not clear any vegetation or remove any natural ground coverage (twigs or branches). Do not attach anything to trees or vegetation (including tent ropes or lights).

Fire

Firewood is allowed to be brought on site however it must be clean, milled timber. No treated or painted wood is allowed to be burnt on-site. Please visit reception, bistro or gelato bar to purchase firewood. All fires must be in a brazier and off the ground. Guests are not permitted to gather wood from within this designated National Park.

All fires must be supervised at all times and extinguished if unattended. No fires to be left burning during the night. Ash must be disposed of in the ash bins provided around the park.

Visitors must obey all fire restrictions enacted by Queensland Parks & Wildlife Service and/or Queensland Fire and Emergency Services. No fires are permitted in the recreation foreshore area on the beach of Lake Cootharaba.

Vehicles

One vehicle per site, additional vehicles must be parked in the visitor parks by reception.

Speed Limit

A maximum speed of 5km's per hour across the entire park.

Generators

Generators are permitted for a maximum of 2 hours per day between the hours of 9am and 6pm.

Noise

Guests must not play music or make any noise between 10pm and 6am. Noise travels easily within the park. Please be courteous to your fellow campers and maintain noise levels to a reasonable and non-disruptive level.

Food

Please be mindful not to leave un-contained food items in or around your campsite as this could become appealing to wildlife, who are not to be fed any human food items as this can be unhealthy for them. Please do not feed the wildlife.

Dump point/Grey water disposal

Guest must ensure grey water and any other waste products are captured and contained. These can be disposed of at the onsite dump point/waste collection area. Human waste and toilet paper only to be disposed of in the dump point. Strictly no other products such as wipes or sanitary products allowed.

Children

Children must always be supervised, please do not let them feed or chase the wildlife here at **habitatnoosa**. Children must be over 2 years of age to utilise watercraft and must always be accompanied by an adult.

Damage

Any damage must be reported – fees and charges may be applicable.

Wildlife

As we are in a National Park, wildlife has the right of way – please keep a safe distance. Do not interfere with nesting birds. Do not feed the wildlife. Domestic animals are prohibited.

Happy Campers

Please remember to be respectful to both the environment and your neighbour - consideration is the key to happy campers.
