PARK INFORMATION & RULES

General Park Information

Check In/Check out

Glamping: Check-in time is 3pm

Camping: Check-in time is 12 midday

Check out is 10am for all glamping & camping

*Late departure fee applies after 10am

*Your access key must be returned on departure or fees apply

Vehicles:

- One vehicle per site.
- Additional vehicles to be parked in visitor carpark.

Vegetation:

- Do not move/clear natural vegetation or attach items to trees.

Food:

- Store food securely. Do not leave food out, it attracts wildlife.

Waste Disposal:

- Grey water and waste products must be disposed of in the dedicated dump point on site.
- Grey water must never be released on the ground.
- Only human waste and toilet paper allowed.
- No wipes or sanitary products.



Wi-Fi:

Wi-Fi is available near the CootharaBAR & Bistro from 6:00am to 9:30pm.

Network: Habitat Noosa FREE Guest Wi-Fi.

No password required.

Safety Guidelines

Fire Safety

- Only clean, milled timber is allowed for fires (no treated/painted wood).
- Fires must be in a brazier and off the ground.
- Must be supervised at all times and extinguished if unattended.
- Ash must be disposed of in provided ash bins.
- No fires allowed to burn overnight.
- Follow all fire restrictions issued by Queensland Parks & Wildlife Fire and Emergency Services.

Generators:

- Maximum run time of 2 hours per day per generator between 9am–6pm.

Noise:

- No music or noise from 10pm–6am.
- Penalty fee of \$500 applies if security is called during quiet hours.

Children:

- Must be supervised at all times.
- Do not let them feed or chase wildlife.
- Must be over 7 years old to use watercraft and always supervised by an adult.

Wildlife:

- Do not touch, approach, or feed kangaroos or other animals.
- No domestic animals allowed (it's a National Park).

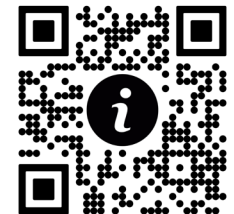
Speed Limit:

- Maximum speed is 5 km/h throughout the park.
